To Whom It May Concern,

The Red Rock Canyon National Conservation Area (RRCNCA) and Sloan Canyon National Conservation Area (SCNCA) are in full support of the Trails Access Project. Both RRCNCA and SCNCA are located just a few miles outside of the Las Vegas valley, which is home to over two million residents and a plethora of visitors every year.

The Trail Access Project will provide detailed trail information for potential visitors, which is not currently available. It will allow persons with disabilities to decide for themselves whether or not a trail is accessible for them and their abilities. The RRCNCA and SCNCA plan to post this information online in addition to having it available in the visitor centers and on signage at the trailheads. This type of information is of interest to both National Conservation Areas in order to improve the experience of visitors of all abilities. It will aid in determining which trails require only minor modifications to make them more accessible.

The trails we plan to assess in RRCNCA are located near our Red Rock Canyon Visitor Center and along our 13-mile scenic drive. The trails to be assessed at SCNCA are accessible at their contact station in Henderson, Nevada.

In addition, we know of no issue that would prevent this project from occurring on our trails. The assessment work and installation of signage are already covered through existing management documents for the trails and will not require additional NEPA.
